Studies have shown that community based anti-drug coalitions are very effective in reducing drug use. Because every community has its own unique drug-related problems, the Florida Counterdrug Training Academy (FCTA), in conjunction with state and national prevention experts, has developed a curriculum designed to assist in the development and sustainment of Community Anti-Drug Coalitions. Participants attending this course will learn to build the foundation of an effective coalition by:

- ⇒ Recognizing the need to mobilize a community's own resources;
- ⇒ Understanding risk and protective factors;
- ⇒ Developing comprehensive strategies for prevention programs;
- ⇒ Becoming familiar with measurement tools;
- ⇒ Accepting the need to evaluate and publicize programs.

The Community Anti-Drug Coalition Building course is conducted monthly at Camp Blanding in Starke, Florida. Training spans the length of three days and is provided free of charge to every community. A travel day is added to the beginning of each session, in order to get participants to Camp Blanding in ample time to prepare for the focused instruction. All meals and on-site lodging are also provided free of charge to every participant. Each class can accommodate up to 30 community members.
